I thought i would give myself a project last week as i was bored at work and this is what i done. first i got some old lights of ebay and drew 2 circles on each light where i wanted my lights to sit.



then i cut out the holes using a hole saw 102mm wide





then i gutted out the back of the light with my dremel but i left the mounting screws so i can attach them back to the car.



here is the tub i used to make the pockets for the led lights






i put the tubs in making sure i had the right angles on both lights then glue them in with super glue







then i fibre glassed them in from the back only.



i cut the tubs down with a hacksaw blade.






i then rubbed the lights down with 220 grit sand paper so that the filler would stick to the lights.




here it is with the filler before rubbing down.

i then cut centre holes out for the middle lights with a hole saw 60mm then i primered them and rubbed down with 500 grit then 1200 grit to get smooth for painting




